New, junior membership is \$20 (First year dues include a club T-shirt)


Junior membership renewal is \$5 per year

Reinstatement (\$25 full or \$20 Social/Jr.) does not include a T-shirt and other benefits


Payment of dues will be accepted at the monthly meetings and at most of the cruise-ins and car shows, or may be mailed directly to the club Treasurer Brent Miller.

CAR SHOWS AND CRUISES ATTENDED




