SUNSHINE NEWS

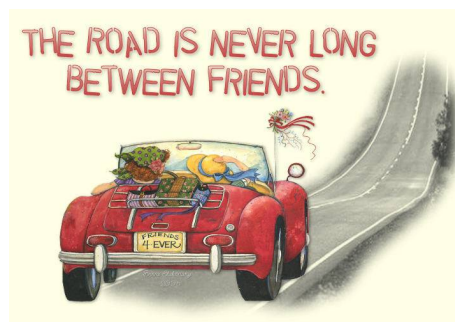
