#### **CLUB DUES REMAIN THE SAME**

Club membership runs concurrently with the calendar year. Therefore, dues for the 2019 year are <u>currently being accepted</u> and will continue to be accepted until the end of the year. At that point, dues will begin being collected for the entire 2020 year. Please note that the fees remain unchanged since the club was founded in 2002, and are extremely reasonable: so, there is no reason not to join or renew. The costs are as follow:

New, <u>full membership</u> is \$25 (First year dues include a club T-shirt & AAC dash card) Membership renewal is \$10 per year

New, <u>social</u> member, i.e., spouse or no car, is \$20 (First year dues include a club T-shirt) Social membership renewal is \$5 per year

New, junior membership is \$20 (First year dues include a club T-shirt)

Junior membership renewal is \$5 per year

Reinstatement after two years (\$25 full or \$20 Social/Jr.) does not include a T-shirt and other benefits

#### FUND RAISING EVENTS SCHEDULED

Our/your club's first three fund raising events have been scheduled for the winter/spring, 2019. Please remember that you must present the appropriate coupon to your waiter or waitress upon paying your check, otherwise the club will not earn any money. One coupon is depicted that you may cut out, if you do not acquire any others elsewhere at a later date (Note: they will be emailed closer to the scheduled event, or may be picked up at our meetings and the club's indoor picnic). The first fund raising event is scheduled for <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>March 5</u> at both locations of <u>Harshbarger's Sub 'N Malt Restaurant</u>, the one is located on Swamp Road in Mifflintown and the other on Route 22 in McVeytown.
