CLUB DUES AND MEMBERSHIP

Club membership runs concurrently with the calendar year. Therefore, dues for the 2020 year are currently being accepted and will continue to be accepted until the end of the year.

At that point, dues will begin being collected for the entire 2021 year. Please note that the fees remain unchanged since the club was founded in 2002, and are extremely reasonable: so, there is no reason not to join or renew. The costs are as follow:

New, full membership is \$25 (First year dues include a club T-shirt & AAC dash card)

Membership renewal is \$10 per year

New, social member, i.e., spouse or no car, is \$20 (First year dues include a club T-shirt)

Social membership renewal is \$5 per year

New, junior membership is \$20 (First year dues include a club T-shirt)

Junior membership renewal is \$5 per year

Reinstatement after two years (\$25 full or \$20 Social/Jr.) does not include a T-shirt and other benefits

Payment of dues will be accepted at the monthly meetings, and at most of the cruise-ins and car shows, or they may be mailed directly to the club Treasurer Brent Miller at his home address – 117 North 3rd Street, Mifflintown, PA. 17059.

2019 RECAP

2019 was an extremely busy year as far as scheduled car-related events were concerned. Besides the car shows, both local and distant, attended by various Cruizers, numerous ones were co-hosted by, or supported by, our club members. They included, but were not limited to, those in Thompston, Millerstown, McClure, McVeytown, Reedsville, Burnham, and Middleburg, Lewistown's Grace Covenant Church, Fayette Carnival in McAlisterville, and the Pink Out Car Show and Old Home Foliage Days in Port Royal. Our car club also hosted or co-hosted nine cruise-ins (two in Perry County, two in Juniata County, and five in Mifflin County). The club also hosted a toy drive at the Mifflintown location of Harshbarger's Sub 'N Malt Restaurant that benefitted needy families in the tri-county area, as well as contributing to two other toy drives, specifically Kneppy's Toy Drive and the Seven Mountains Jeeps Toy Drive. Six fund raising events, at three different local restaurants, made it possible for our club to make monetary donations of \$1000 to each of the three food banks which we support annually, not to mention the six contributions of canned goods and non-perishable items delivered. Several impromptu cruises, along country roads, were taken to various state parks, other points of interest, and unique eating establishments. During the "off season," members and guests enjoyed get-togethers at our eight scheduled Saturday Morning Breakfasts, both at the Red Zone in Mifflintown and the OIP in Burnham. We could go on and on, but you get the gist - we are a

social club, contributing to various charitable organizations, and yet enjoying ourselves at events near and far.

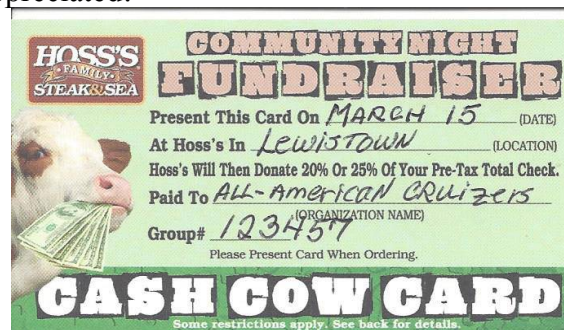
