CLUB DUES AND MEMBERSHIP



Club membership runs concurrently with the calendar year. Therefore, dues for the 2020 year are currently being accepted and will continue to be accepted until the end of the year. At that point, dues will begin being collected for the entire 2021 year. Please note that the fees remain unchanged since the club was founded in 2002, and are extremely reasonable: so, there is no reason not to join or renew. The costs are as follow:

New, full membership is \$25 (First year dues include a club T-shirt & AAC dash card)

Membership renewal is \$10 per year

New, social member, i.e., spouse or no car, is \$20 (First year dues include a club T-shirt)

Social membership renewal is \$5 per year

New, junior membership is \$20 (First year dues include a club T-shirt)

Junior membership renewal is \$5 per year

Reinstatement after two years (\$25 full or \$20 Social/Jr.) does not include a T-shirt and other benefits

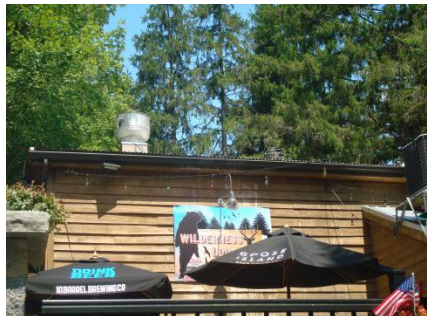


WHEELS AT THE WILDERNESS
