THOMPSONTOWN TOY DRIVE

October 15 was the date of the annual cruise-in/toy drive held, this year, at Regester Chevrolet, off Main Street, in Thompsontown. It was a very cloudy, fall evening, the first ever Friday night toy drive ever held, with threatening rain clouds and temperatures in the low 70's before darkness set in. Some 22 antique and classic vehicles were registered, 10 owned by fellow club members. 24 Cruizers were in attendance along with approximately 40-50 other people there for the Elvis Tribute Show. The Cruizers, other car enthusiasts, and visitors were treated to live music by Denny Heckard, a local Elvis impersonator from Newport. Food was prepared and sold by the Thompsontown Fire Company. The club collected a large number of toys and boxed them up for storage until the Toys for Tots Campaign commences, to be displayed in the dealership at that time. Donnie Guthridge was the winner of the 50-50 drawing, \$60 to him and \$59 to the club for the purchase of additional toys. Some \$142 was also donated by members and visitors to purchase additional toys in the club's name. Don and Sally Roberts are charged with that responsibility. The dealership will, in turn, donate \$5 for each toy collected for the purchase of even more toys. Marine Corps personnel will then pick up the toys, wrap them, and distribute them to needy children in the tri-county area so that they have a nice Christmas. Finally, a huge **THANK YOU** goes out to the dealership of Regester Chevrolet for everything they did to help with this cruise-in, and to one and all of you for attending and making this club event such a SUCCESS.
