New, <u>full membership</u> is \$25 (First year dues include a club T-shirt & AAC dash card) Membership renewal is \$10 per year

New, <u>social</u> member, i.e., spouse or no car, is \$20 (First year dues include a club T-shirt) Social membership renewal is \$5 per year

New, junior membership is \$20 (First year dues include a club T-shirt)

Junior membership renewal is \$5 per year

Reinstatement after two years (\$25 full or \$20 Social/Jr.) does not include a T-shirt and other benefits;


