CAR CLUB EVENTS ATTENDED

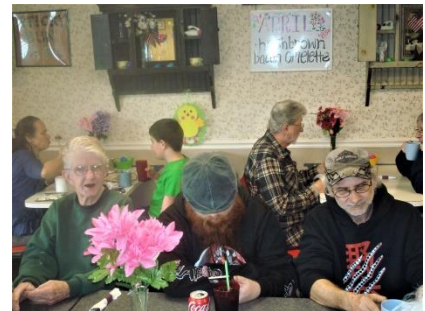
MCALISTERVILLE FUNDRAISER
