Reinstatement after two years (\$25 full or \$20 Social/Jr.) does not include a T-shirt and other benefits;



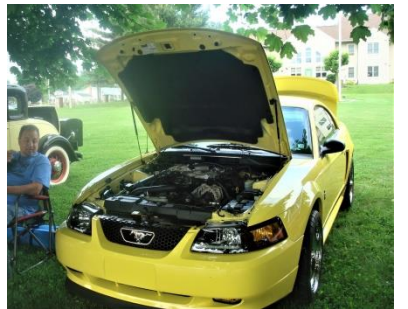
