REEDSVILLE CRUISE-IN

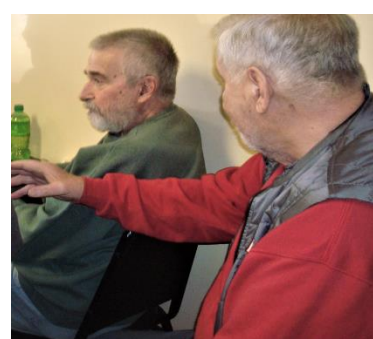

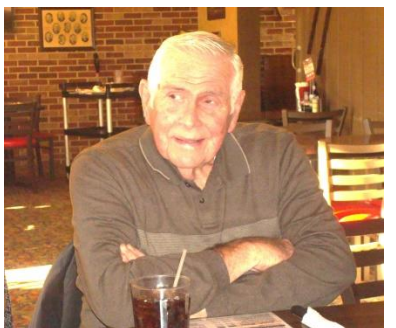


HOSS’S FUNDRAISER

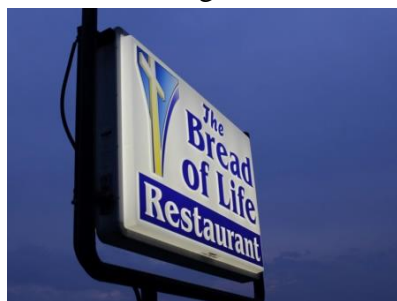
HARSHBARGER'S FUNDRAISER
