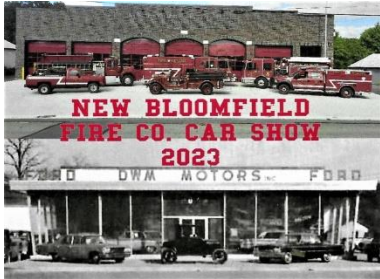
MCCLURE CAR SHOW
