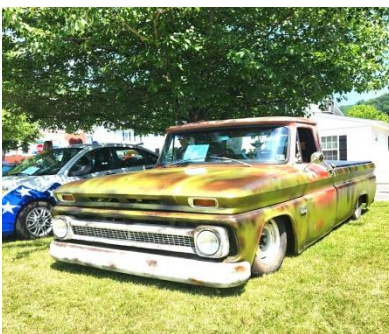
## MCVEYTOWN CRUISE-IN
