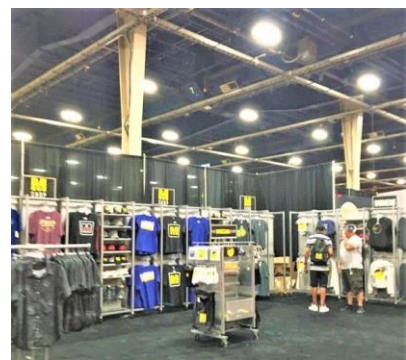

HARRISBURG AUCTION

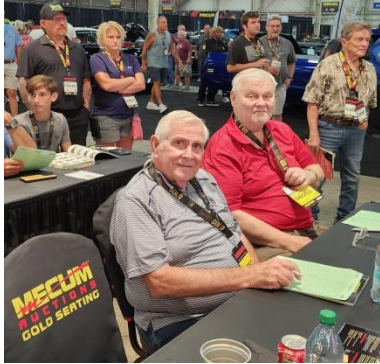
